## SPEAKER INFORMATION

### Noel Dean

**Noel Dean** is more than a championship football coach — he is a builder of people, programs, and communities. Over more than three decades as a head coach, educator, and mentor, Dean has led teams to multiple state championships while shaping generations of young athletes into confident leaders. Known for building winning cultures from the ground up, his programs emphasize discipline, accountability, and belief to achieve success on and off the field.

Dean's impact extends far beyond the scoreboard. Through community initiatives and "cause games," most notably the nationally recognized **Pink Arrow Pride Game**, he has used football as a platform to unite communities, support families battling cancer, and teach players the importance of serving something bigger than themselves.

The same values he teaches have shaped his own family. All four of Dean's children were college athletes — including three sons who graduated from Harvard University and a daughter who played soccer at Ferris State University and now attends Michigan State University's College of Human Medicine. These experiences as both a coach and father give him a unique perspective on developing young people and raising resilient, high-character leaders.

As a motivational speaker, Dean shares lessons from the locker room, classroom, and community about leadership, character, and overcoming adversity. His message inspires coaches, educators, parents, and athletes to build stronger cultures and invest in the next generation.

### **The Unintended Awesomeness of a Giving Mindset**

Noel will remind us in a numbers-driven healthcare environment, it is essential to remember that people remain at the heart of the work we do. Beyond improving the health of those we serve, adopting **a positive, non-transactional mindset** can also enhance the experience of those providing care and support. When we focus on **human connection** rather than purely transactional interactions, our work becomes more meaningful and enjoyable. He will draw on personal experiences from a patient and consumer perspective — particularly a life-changing childhood illness—as well as from community-building efforts like the Pink Arrow Pride Project. Through relatable, real-life examples, He will connect these experiences back to our needs and the value of keeping people at the center of healthcare.
